

Personal Injuries Assessment Board – Notice regarding on-line applications

Upgraded on-line application form – implications for claimants who have already started to complete an on-line application but have not finalised and submitted it:

If you have started to complete an on-line application form, but have not actually finalised and submitted it, and you intend pursuing an application through the Personal Injuries Assessment Board, **you need to finish completing the existing form and submit it before the end of May, 2017.***

As and from the end of May* if you wish to complete an on-line application form you will need to restart your application and input **all** information into the new form.

Upgraded on-line application form – implications for claimants who intend to make an application on-line:

If you wish to make an application on-line before the end of May 2017* you need to complete the existing form fully and submit it before the end of May 2017*. If you partially complete the existing form and do not finalise and submit it before the end of May 2017* you will need to start over again when the new form is live.

As and from the end of May 2017* if you wish to complete an on-line application form, you will need to input **all** information into the new form
