

Free advice for ICA members on personal injury claims

THE Personal Injuries Board, which can be accessed on the internet under injuriesboard.ie, is a statutory body which provides independent assessment of personal injury compensation for victims of workplace, motor and public liability accidents.

This assessment is provided without the need for the majority of current litigation costs, such as solicitors, barristers and experts' fees, associated with such claims.

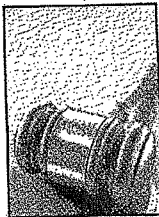
The board assesses the amount of compensation due to an injured party and delivers compensation without legal costs and experts fees that add over 46% to the cost of a claim.

They reduce the amount of time it takes to finalise a compensation claim. Under the court system it can take approximately three years to settle a claim. It can take nine months to settle a personal injury claim via injuriesboard.ie.

injuriesboard.ie is an independent government body which assesses compensation due to a person who has suffered a personal injury.
